GENERAL

Relationship between Universiti Putra Malaysia and Putra Business School

Putra Business School (PBS), which was formerly known as the Graduate School of Management (GSM), is privately owned by Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM). This is reflected in the governance structure, where the Vice Chancellor and the Deputy Vice Chancellor of UPM are permanent members of Yayasan Putra Business School (YPBS). The Vice Chancellor of UPM chairs PBS' Board of Governors (BOG); UPM's Vice Chancellor, UPM's Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic), and one representative from UPM's Board of Directors (BOD) sit on YPBS' Board of Directors (BOD); The representative from UPM's BOD chairs YPBS' BOD.

APPLICATION

1. How do I apply and submit my application?

Application is done online at

https://portal.putrabusinessschool.edu.my/applicant/

Applicants should register a new account before filling in the details based on the checklist given.

2. Is the processing fee included in the programme fees?

No, it is not. The processing fee during submission for local applicants is RM60.00, and for international applicants it is RM150.00. However, the processing fee is waived if applicants join the Virtual Open Day (VOD) and submit the application before the expiry date of the waiver voucher. 3. What do I do after receiving my offer letter?

Congratulations! You are just one step closer to officially being a PBS student. You may accept the offer through the portal and make the necessary payment before getting the registration slip, containing your Matric No. and password to log in to the Students Portal.

4. Is it compulsory for me to do a medical check-up?

Local students need to provide their medical check-up report within 1 month after registering as our students. For international students, upon entering Malaysia, the international office executive will guide you on getting a medical check-up. MBA-ODL and DBA-ODL students are not required to do a medical check-up.

5. Is there any financial assistance?

6. How do I utilise the facility under EPF?

You need to have an account with EPF. Withdrawals can be made from your account 2 by visiting the EPF website at https://iakaun.kwsp.gov.my/portal/member/login

You may apply after registering as a student of PBS. Do inquire with us by emailing the programme's executive.

7. What is meant by the Student Referral Scheme (SRS)?

The Student Referral Scheme (SRS) is the incentive provided for PBS students, alumni and staff who successfully recruit students for PBS. The applicant needs to submit the online application stating the name of the introducer. The commission rates for successful applications are RM1500.00 for an international applicant and RM1000.00 for a local applicant. For more

8. How do I access the library facilities?

Access will be granted after you successfully register as a student of PBS. You will be issued a password to access the materials available at the PBS Resource Centre and the UPM library.

9. Does PBS provide accommodation for their students?

PBS will assist our students in getting accommodation at Mohamad Rashid College, UPM. Besides, there are a variety of accommodation options near PBS to suit your personal budget. 10. What amenities are provided nearby?

11. What would I require to access the Open Learning Platform or Putra LMS?

Once you register as a PBS student, you will be given a password to log in to your PBS email account. This email account would provide access to the Open Learning Platform or Putra Learning Management Systems (Putra LMS).

13. Can I postpone or take a break from my studies?

Yes, postponement of studies or deferment is allowed twice (2) for medical reasons. Please write officially to us so that your student status will be updated accordingly. Deferment must be made within the first two weeks of a trimester/semester. Otherwise, all the paid fees will be forfeited.

INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

1. I am an international student. How will the students' pass, visas, etc., be processed?

International students are advised to refer to the guidelines posted at the student portal.

2. When will I receive my i-Card?

The I-card will be available within one (1) month after the student's pass is issued. However, do visit the student portal and look out for the announcement before coming to the PBS Student Centre to collect it.

3. What should I do if I need to go to the clinic/hospital for treatment?

Healthcare costs in Malaysia are relatively high compared to other countries in Southeast Asia. A sudden illness or accident requiring hospitalisation can quickly result in medical bills totalling thousands of Ringgit. In compliance with the Malaysian Ministry of Higher Education's Code of Ethics, all international students must be covered by insurance throughout their duration of studies. 4. As an international student, what is the requirement for me to open a bank account?

You will need to bring a letter confirming your status as our student. Please complete the LLD001 form, which can be downloaded from the student portal, and submit it to the respective executive through email. The letter will be ready within 3 working days.
